






HOW DO PEOPLE TALK ABOUT DISCIPLESHIP?

% among Christian adults NOT choosing "discipleship" as preferred term















ESTIMATES OF MEMBER INVOLVEMENT IN DISCIPLESHIP ACTIVITIES








